Requirements for Certification

- All animals must be sired by pedigree registered AA Bull.
- All animals' passports must confirm the animal's breed as AA or AAX.
- All members must be BBQA (Bord Bia Quality Assured) and a signed-up member of the Angus Beef Ireland producer group.
- Please check with your agent before sending cattle, that your animals and your herd meet the processor's certified Angus contract requirements.
- These specifications can vary factory to factory depending on certified Angus contract terms and conditions.
- All animals are visually inspected for Angus traits in the lairage.
- Animals will not be certified if they fail lairage visual inspection.
- AA animals are polled, but soft /scur horns are acceptable on AAX animals.
- Regular random DNA tissue samples are taken and tested to establish the percentage Angus in each animal.
- Animals sampled which do not meet the required minimum percentage Angus will be notified to you and the relevant processor in writing, (in line with our breed assignment policy)
